

Falkirk Branch of Seagull Trust Cruises 2017 Cruises

The **Govan Seagull** and **Barr Seagull** offer **FREE** cruises for parties of people of all ages and disabilities on the Union Canal from the Trust's Reception Centre Boathouse in South Bantaskine Estate, Falkirk FK1 5EF.

Bookings are restricted to a maximum of 12 passengers, including helpers, and will be allocated on a first come first serve basis from 3rd April - 13th October 2017.

The boats are approximately 50 feet long and 10 feet wide and were custom built to serve disabled people. They are fitted with wheelchair ramps, hydraulic lifts and appropriate toilet facilities. It is the responsibility of the group to ensure the ratio of helpers (min 2) to disabled people is adequate. Advance notice of the number of wheelchairs passengers (max 4) is requested to help avoid delays as the cabin layout will need to be altered before embarkation.

Tea, coffee and biscuits are provided on all cruises at no charge.

We have a range of cruises available to suit your needs.

Cruises start at 10.30am and 2 pm (1.30pm for cruise 5) or at other times by arrangement.

Cruise 3 will stop for approx 1 hour somewhere along the canal to allow lunch to be eaten.

Cruise 4 can only be booked as a morning cruise and Cruise 5 can only be booked as an afternoon cruise, as it leaves from the Falkirk Wheel.
